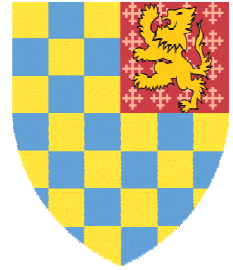


# Lewes Priory Cricket Club

Lewes Priory Cricket Club is pleased to announce that they will run the Super Sixes tournament again this year. The format will remain much the same as last season. The Finals Day being on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2010.

### **Format**

The first round runs over several nights, with each team drawn into a group of four. The teams then play each other in the round robin format, one game a night to decide the group positions.

The games commence as close to 6pm as is possible. Teas are provided and the bar will be open.

The semi-finals, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> play-off and Grand Final will all be played on the same day.

### **Dates**

First round matches will be played in the evenings throughout May and June.

The quarter-finals will be held at the beginning of July

The semi-finals and finals will be held on afternoon and evening of Sunday, 18<sup>th</sup> July.

Please complete and return the attached entry form along with the entry fee. The entry fee is £100.

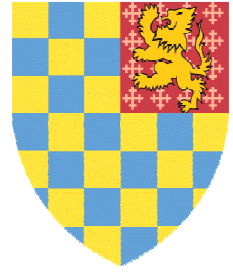

## Super Sixes

### RULES

Normal 11 man cricket rules will apply except as follows:

Whites are the preferred attire, but something suitably sporty is ok if you can't find any.

Matches will be played as 10, 6 ball overs per side.

All overs shall be bowled from the same end – chosen by mutual agreement of the team captains prior to the toss of the coin for each game.

Batsmen swap ends at the end of each over.

A batsman scoring 25 or over not out will retire immediately but may rejoin the end of the batting order. He does NOT have to retire after another 25 runs.

All fielders, apart from the wicket-keeper, must bowl a minimum of one over and a maximum of three.

The wicket-keeper cannot be changed during a match.

A score of two runs will be given for each wide and each no ball.

Extra balls will be bowled.

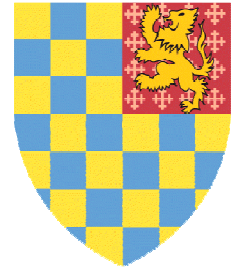
If, after 30 minutes of the 1<sup>st</sup> innings, the fielding side is obviously not going to complete their overs in good time, then the umpires will close the innings at the end of one more over. The 2<sup>nd</sup> innings will then be played over the same number of overs received as in the 1<sup>st</sup> innings.

Two points will be awarded to the winning team. One point will be awarded to each team in the event of a tie.

If at the end of a Round Robin, for teams that are tied on points – the winner shall be decided by run rate calculated over the games played.

The umpire's decision is final!
